General Meet Regulations:

1. Participation and take-off permission

The rules and regulations (WB and RO) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV) and the anti-doping regulations will be in full force during the competition. The competition is open to members of clubs or teams belonging to a DSV associated federation. The competition is also open to all foreign members of clubs or teams (as far as their national federations are FINA's members and are entitled to compete).

2. Licence and health declarations

The competition is open only to swimmers who are in hold of a valid DSV ID-card and have paid the annual license fee according to § 20 WB. A mandatory medical examination must be completed in the year of the meet (WB § 7). When registering participants must confirm that they are healthy and fit. Disciplinary actions according to §§ 15, 16 WB will be taken against participants violating the participating permission.

These regulations only apply to clubs and teams which belong to a DSV associated federation.

3. Specification of the pool

The swimming pool is 25 m long with 5 lanes. Manual timing devices will be used. The one-start-rule will apply – no false start. Heats will be set and timed without consideration of age groups. **There will be no acceptance of changes on the day of competition. The confirmation receipt of entry applies.**

4. Enrollment / Registration

Please use the DSV-forms no. 101 and 102 for registration. For electronic registrations please use standard DSV-file format 5. Files can be found under www.eku-cup.de. Participants in a relay team have to include the planned relay-ID in the entry form. Please send registrations to:

Incomplete registrations or registrations with obvious misstatements cannot be accepted. **The organizer subjects to limit the number of heats to 998.** According to this, surplus entries will be rejected. The fastest entries take priority.

Final entry date: Wednesday, September 22nd 2010, 10.00 o'clock p.m. CET

Information on the outcome of registrations is available on the club homepage: www.eku-cup.de. On arrival each team will receive all relevant documents.

5. Entry Fees

The entry fee is **4.50 Euro** per person and each start. The entry per relay is **6.00 Euro**. Payment checks should be enclosed to the registration form. Alternative you can transfer the entry fee to the following banking account:

Registrations in DSV-file format receive a discount of 0.50 Euro.

Registrations prior to June 22nd receive a discount of 1.00 Euro for each registration.

6. Scoring and Prices

Points will be counted separately for male and female individual events. The 1st to 6th places will receive prizes sponsored by **EKU**. Overall winner is the club with the highest accumulated score of all events (male and female). They win the challenge cup sponsored by **EKU**, the **EKU Cup**. The challenge cup remains with the club that wins it three times in a row or five times out of sequence.

EKU Cup winner 2009: SSV Leutzsch-Leipzig

Clubs with 25 or less entries are entitled to swim for the **Small EKU Cup**. Winner is the club with 25 or less entries that achieves the highest accumulated score of all events.

The first six places of each age group in each event will be awarded points. The first place scores 6 points, the second place 5 points, etc., with the 6 place scoring 1 point. Depending on age group and club only one relay will count to the overall score. Places 1-6 in each age group will receive certificates. The first three relay teams will also receive certificates.

Single age groups: the first place of each age group will receive a miniature beer mug. The six swimmers (male and female) with the best result in points according to the valid DSV-Comparative performance table for swimming will receive **material prizes**. The three best individual starts will be counted. The victory ceremony will take place during the competition and afterwards in the city hall.

Every participant receives as a souvenir a limited EKU-Cup glass and a 0.33l – bottle of beer.

7. Evening Party with Tombola

After the competition follows an evening party. **The address where the party will take place will be announced in time.** There will be play a band and it is possible to victual with characteristic Franconian dishes. While the evening party the award of the first prizes as well as the **draw of three special prizes** out of the participant cards of all present participants will take place in the. **An after-event party will take place afterwards.**

8. Panel of judges

The clubs are asked to appoint one judge each.
