TO THE 22ND INTERNATIONAL MASTERS SWIMMING OF THE SCHWIMMUNION HALL IN TIROL



Date: July 16-17, 2011

Location: "Freischwimmbad" Hall in Tirol (outdoor pool)
The competition pool is 50 m long and has 8 lanes. The water temperature is 26°C. The water depth ranges from 1,20 m to 1,60 m.

Registration: Entries have to be made by stating the athlete's year of birth, the age group, and the entry times. The entry forms have to be sent to **SCHWIMMUNION HALL; z.Hd. Bernhard Stecher, Bei der Säule 8, 6060 Hall in Tirol. The entries can also be emailed (office@su-hall.at), or sent by FAX (no. +43(0)5223/53463). By submitting an entry form each participant certifies his/her health and ability to take part in swimming competitions.**

Dead line: Entry deadline is June 26, 2011 (postmark)
Registration forms sent after this date cannot be accepted due to organisational reasons.
Late registration or changes are NOT possible!

Seeding: Heats will be arranged by entry times without regard to the swimmers' age. The results will be separated according to the age groups.

Relays: Relays will be swum in five age group categories:
Cat. I = total age 100 - 119 yrs.
Cat. II = total age 120 - 159 yrs.
Cat. III = total age 160 - 199 yrs.
Cat. IV = total age 200 -.239 yrs
Cat. V = total age 240 yrs. and older
The relay winners of each category will receive an award.

Entry-fee: EUR 5,00 per single event
EUR 7,- per relay-
Fees are to be paid by cash or by Eurocheck in Euro on the first day of competition or may be transferred to the account of the Schwimmunion@citynet.hall, no. 1800-011791 at Tiroler Sparkasse, routing code 20503 (SWIFT- / BIC-CODE SPIHAT22, IBAN AT 21 20503 01800011791).

Prizes: The top three swimmers of each event and each age group will be awarded medals and certificates, which will be presented during the competition.

Further certificates and paper results must be ordered at the registration desk prior to the competition and will be handed out to a club representative at the end of the competition. A pdf-file of the result sheet will be distributed via internet (www.su-hall.at).

Regardless of the individual results the hand-minted Hall Achievement Medallion will be awarded to those participants who reach 1300 points in three events (according to the DSV Masters table), except the 800 m freestyle event.

In addition, the highest score in each age group will be awarded a cup.

The 800m freestyle event is registered as part of the International Austrian Masters Championships 2011. **ATTENTION: According to the rules of FINA and OSV, Austrian Championship titles will only be assigned to AG 25 and older.** In this event, the top three swimmers of each age group will be awarded medals. In addition, a prize will be awarded – regardless of the age group – to the five best male and female results according to the DSV Masters table. The award ceremony for this competition will be held immediately after the event.

Program: The program and the entry cards (for free entry to the swimming pool) will be distributed on **Saturday, 16 July 2011, starting at 12:00 am.**
